Vaagdevi college of Pharmacy has a research aim of

"Striving towards Excellence". The research culture is in its infancy and needs attention. Some of the research skills in new areas are under progress and few research articles, book chapters and patents have been published. Workshops on IPR are organized to motivate faculty to apply for patents.

Interactions are arranged with academic institutions and nearby industries for enhancing teaching-learning process, research and training and placement. Students are encouraged to participate in various activities through MoUs which enables holistic education. Five patents and few books/ book chapters have been contributed by faculty. Case studies have been incorporated in the book based on experiences so that in house students and researchers are benefited. Seed money is provided by the management to faculty for research activities. Few faculty members have been awarded and recognized for their research contributions. The institution was allotted a National Service Scheme Unit and this cell is active in its extension activities.
