1) Restricted Entry of Automobiles

Restricting the entry of automobiles to the campus plays a significant role in reducing both air and noise pollution. 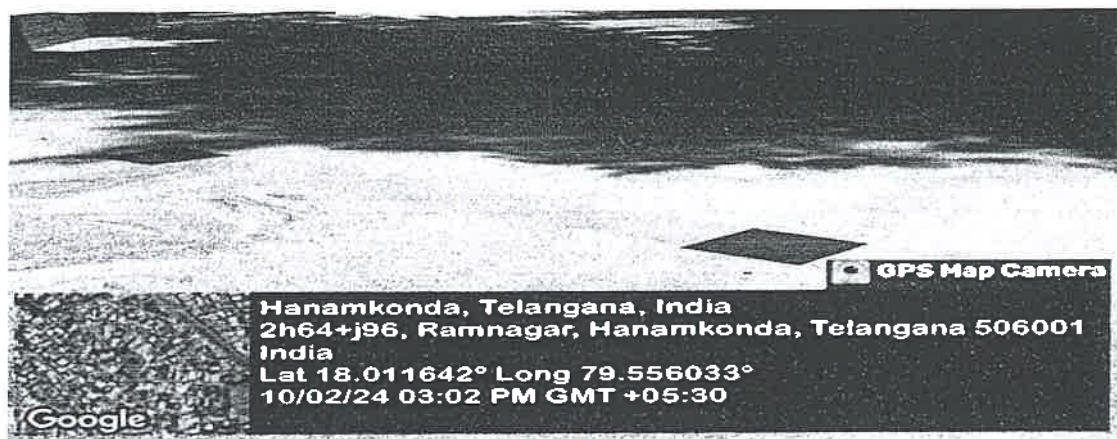

3) Pedestrian Friendly Pathway

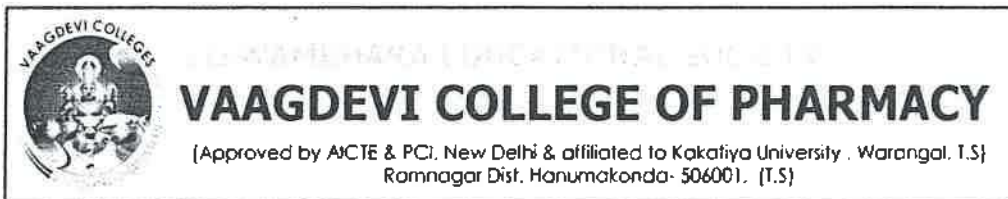

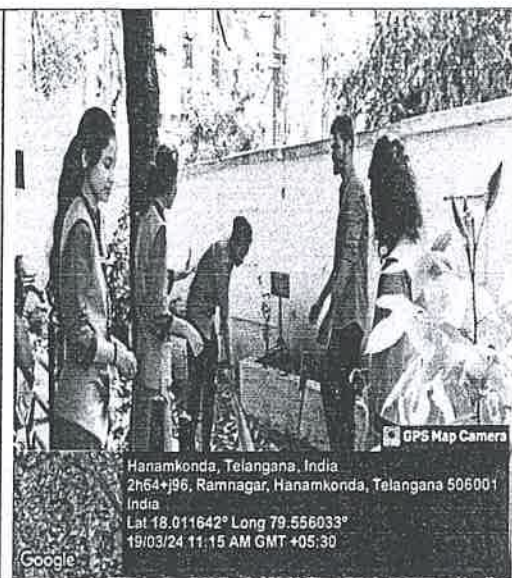

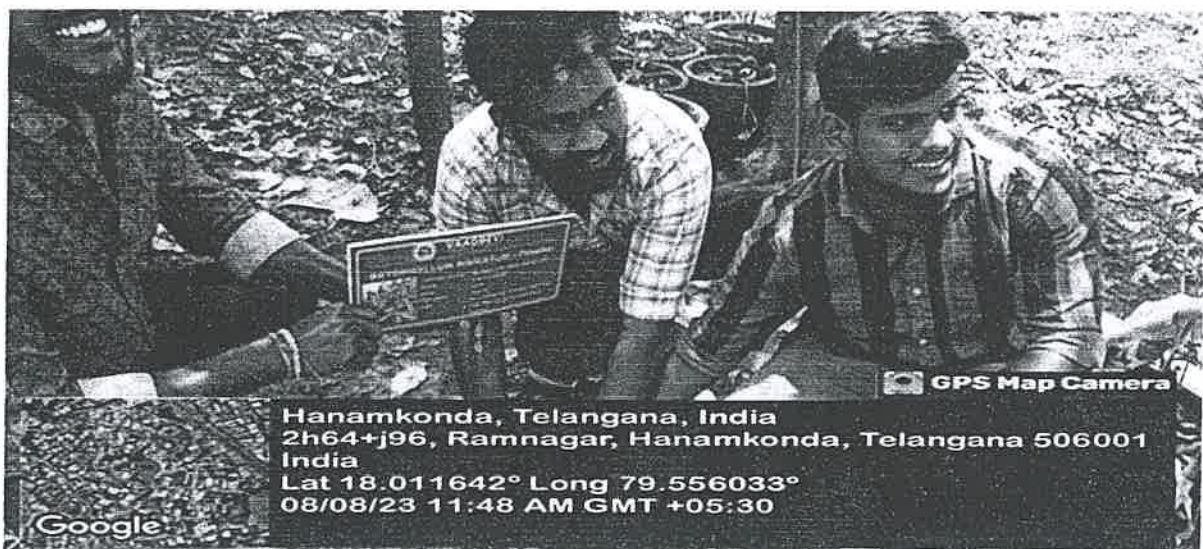
