### 1) Restricted Entry of Automobiles

Restricting the entry of automobiles to the campus plays a significant role in reducing both air and noise pollution. By limiting the use of two-wheelers, four-wheelers, and electric bikes to designated parking areas, the campus minimizes vehicular emissions and congestion. The monitoring of vehicle entry and exit through CCTV cameras at key locations, such as the entrance gates, corridors, and parking zones, ensures that only authorized vehicles are allowed on campus. Security personnel enforce the restriction of unauthorized vehicle access at the gates. Additionally, maintaining a no-horn policy within the campus further promotes a quieter, more peaceful environment. This combination of measures contributes to a cleaner, safer, and more sustainable campus.
