- > reported by the students and/ or staff if any.

- Mechanism for redressal of grievances: The committee members engaged in a detailed discussion about the existing mechanism for the redressal of grievances within the college. The importance of an effective and transparent grievance redressal process was emphasized. It was decided that the current mechanism would be reviewed and any necessary improvements would be made to ensure prompt and fair resolution of grievances.
- Safeguarding the rights of female students, faculty, and non-teaching staff: The committee recognized the need to strengthen measures to safeguard the rights and well-being of female students, faculty, and non-teaching staff. It was agreed upon that the college would take the following actions:
- Conduct gender sensitization workshops and awareness sessions to promote a respectful and inclusive environment.
- Regularly review and update policies and guidelines to ensure the safety and well-being of all members of the college community.
- Complaint regarding refill of sanitary pads in ladies' washroom: The committee discussed a specific complaint received from a student regarding the need for regular refill of sanitary pads in the ladies' washroom. The committee acknowledged the importance of addressing this issue promptly and maintaining proper hygiene facilities for female students. It was decided that the following actions would be taken:
- Appoint a responsible staff member to regularly monitor and ensure the availability of sanitary pads in the ladies' washroom.
- Conduct periodic inspections to verify the adequacy of sanitary pad supplies and take necessary measures for restocking.

- All the committee members agreed to keep the matters regarding this meeting confidential for better outcome.


