Investigating Alleged Violations: The committee is responsible for investigating complaints and allegations of misconduct, which could involve plagiarism, unprofessional behaviour, drug misuse, or any violation of institutional policies.

Conducting Hearings: The committee may hold hearings when allegations of misconduct are made. This could involve gathering evidence, interviewing witnesses, and ensuring that all parties have a chance to present their case.



Recommending Disciplinary Actions: Based on the investigation, the committee may recommend disciplinary actions for violators, which could include warnings, fines, suspension, or expulsion, depending on the severity of the infraction.

Providing Guidance and Support: The committee also offers guidance to faculty and students on ethical issues and dilemmas that arise in both academic and clinical settings. This may include teaching professional conduct and ethics through workshops, seminars, or classroom sessions.

Ensuring Transparency and Accountability: The committee is tasked with ensuring that its procedures are transparent, and decisions are documented and justified. This is vital for maintaining institutional trust.

Fostering Awareness: The committee often organizes awareness campaigns and programs to educate students and staff about the importance of professional ethics and the consequences of violating the code of conduct.
