

Medical Education – Pharmacy Council of India – Introduced a Pharm.D New Course – Guidelines permitting the students of Pharm.D, Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) Courses to undergo clinical internship / hospital practices in Govt. Hospitals in the State – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

Pharmacy Council of India under section 10 of the Pharmacy Act 1948 (8 of 1948) formulated Pharm.D Regulations, 2008 prescribing the duration of the course and minimum qualifications for Pharm.D and Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate). For both the courses one year of Hospital practices/ Internship in a Hospital is prescribed. As per the above regulations, the applicant of Pharm. D College shall provide 300 bedded own hospital facility or entering into clearly defined Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the teaching hospitals recognized by the MCI or University or Government Hospital or Corporate Hospital not below the level of District Head Quarter Hospitals with 300 beds including housing Pharmacy Practice Department with minimum carpet area of 30 square feet per student along with consent to provide the Professional manpower to support the programme. The number of institutions which can be attached to one hospital shall be restricted by the student pharmacist to bed ratio of 1: 10.

- 3. The Director of Medical Education, Hyderabad has stated that a Committee has been constituted with the following members to recommend the amount of fee to be fixed for Pharm.D and Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) per candidate per annum for residency training/internship. The above said committee has recommended an amount of Rs.25,000/- to be collected as residency training / internship fee from the Pharm.D and Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) students per annum. The Committee has also suggested certain guidelines for entering into MOU with the Management of Pharmacy Colleges. While informing the above recommendations, the Director of Medical Education has requested the Government to issue necessary orders in the matter.
- 4. The Government have examined the recommendation of the above Committee and decided to permit the *DME/ Superintendent of Govt.

 Hospitals including all teaching hospitals to enter into a clearly defined.

 Memorandum of Understandings (MOU) with the Private Managements of Pharmacy Colleges for providing residency training / internship to the students of Pharm.D and Pharm D (Post Baccalaureate) courses with the following terms and conditions:
 - 1. to enter into MOU with the Government hospitals including all teaching hospitals recognized by the MCI or University or Government Hospital not below the level of District Head Quarter Hospitals with 300 beds including housing Pharmacy Practice Department with minimum carpet area of 30 square feet per student along with consent to provide the Professional manpower to support the programme.
 - to enter into MOU with the Corporate type hospital with minimum 300 beds including housing pharmacy practice department with minimum carpet area of 30 square feet per student along with consent to provide the professional manpower to support the programme.
 - Hospitals should have a minimum of 300 beds with the Department of General Medicine as a compulsory speciality and also having atleast (3) of the six (6) clinical specialities i.e., 1) Paediatrics 2) Obsterics & Gynaecology, 3) Surgery 4) Orthopeadics 5) Psychiatry and 6) Skin & VD to enter into MOU with pharmacy colleges.
 - 4. The Superintendents of the Hospitals shall maintain a Register of the Pharmacy colleges and students of Pharmacy, with whom they have entered into MOU and take students for internship as per PCI regulations.
 - Number of institutions which can be attached to one hospital shall be registered by the student pharmacist to bed ratio of 1:10.
 - 6. An amount of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) shall be collected as fees for Residency training / Internship from the Pharm.D and Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) students, per annum / per student and to be deposited with the Hospital Development Society.



5. The Director of Medical Education, Hyderabad / Superintendent of Government Hospitals including all teaching hospitals shall scrutinize the applications received for utilization of Govt. Hospitals for residency training/internship of their students as per the above guidelines and take necessary action to enter into Memorandum of Understanding with the private Pharmacy Colleges.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding was entered on the 15th July 2022 between M/s AVODHA EDUTECH Pvt. Ltd. 1"Floor, Carnival Infopark, Infopark Campus, Kakkanad, 682042 represented by Mr. Joseph E George, Chief Executive Officer(hereinafter referred to as the First Party) and M/s Vangdevi College of Pharmacy, Ramnagar, Hanamkonda, Warangal, 506001 represented by Dr Challa Srinivas Reddy, Principal (Hereinafter referred to as the Second Party), which term shall mean and include his successors, representatives etc., and Whereas the First Party is the Authorized Training Partner to conduct Trainingin 3 job-oriented courses bown as Annexure 1.

The Pagties as mentioned above have decided to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding to meet their respective objectives, which are set out herein below:

a. The First Party, the Authorized Training Partner of AVODHA EDUTECH Pvt.Ltd is interested in associating with the Second Party to establish Vaagdevi College of Pharmacy, Ramnagar, Hanamkonda, Warangal, 506001as an addon provider in order topromote and deliver 3programs of study as detailed in Annexure 1.

b. The Second Party on its part is interested in associating with the First Party for using their expertise to promote the above-mentioned3 courses as additional programs with the

regular programs of the College.

The purpose of this MoU is to set forth the terms and conditions under which the parties to this understanding shall conduct themselves during the subsistence of the memorandum.

1. The First Party shall make all arrangements to enable the M/s Vaagdevi College of Pharmacy, Ramnagar, Hanamkonda, Warangal, 506001is the learning hub of AVODHA EDUTECH, for all Three Certificate Courses.(Annexure 1)

- 2. The Course duration shall be a minimum of 3 months (60-75hours) extendable to one year along with 3 months of internship.
- 3. The First Party shall also provide placement assistance for a period of five years (during which internship can also be availed and students have to pay the rest of the fee Rs.10000/-after getting a job (as per company policy) through Avodha) Students are moved into the placement assistancestage of the service only once they attain course completion which is defined as completing the online course, personalized training and Mock Interviews.
- 4. The First Party shall provide students with an option to attempt for authorized certification of multinational companies or the certification of government /semi-government agencies. The prices listed in Annexure IIImay vary according to the dollar value changes and update in the examination fees or registration fees for authorized certifications of multinational companies or the certification of government /semi-government agencies.
- 5. The Second Party will provide all necessary infrastructure including classroom facilities, computers, electrical power, etc. to the possible extent. The College will have full control over all items said above and will provide the required services. It would even maintain the computers and accessories to the best of its ability and would regularly pay for the electricity and other related expenses.
- 6. The First Party will arrange to install the required soft-wares (as per company policy) for use and to the best satisfaction of the students as per course specifications. They shall also ensure the maintenance and updates of the software periodically if any.
- 7. In order to enrollin a programcandidate will have to remit to the College Officethe course fee of Rs. 2,800/- [Rupees Two ThousandEight Hundred only] and (in the case of students seeking authorized certifications) the Registration and Examination fees specific to each program must be paid separately. (Annexures I & III)
- 8. M/s Vaagdevi College of Pharmacywill be responsible for selecting and arranging the students for training and coaching.

- 11. The First Party shall ensure that every student understands the portions by evaluating their knowledge using a self-assessment test after each module and providing assignments to make them proficient in practical application.
- 12. The First Party shall allow students to opt for any one or combo training programs amongthese courses in Annexure land also provide the option to change the course if they so require.
- 13. It is intended that the terms of this MoU shall remain in force for an initial period of five years. The period of this MoU can be extended further after the expiry of five years on mutual agreement between the parties in writing.
- 14. The terms of this memorandum can be modified at any time by both parties on mutual agreement.
- 15. Either party shall be entitled toterminate the MoU on 30days' notice. The MoU will automatically terminate:
 - 2. if either party becomes insolvent or when there is a change of control with respect to either party
 - b. If any binding agreement becomes unenforceable due to any regulatory orstatutory requirement/compulsion.
 - c. In the event of the termination of the agreement, the First Party agrees to complete the programs being conducted in respect of existing batches on agreed terms
- 16. Whatever disputes and differences of any kindarising out of or in connection with this MoU shall be referred to arbitration, and the final decision of the arbitrator jointly agreed upon and appointed by both parties. 


